



STATEMENT ON ANTI SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR

Greenbelt is a UK wide company, and Anti Social Behaviour is a universal issue (e.g. vandalism, graffiti, flytipping, causing nuisance, etc).

We have no legal powers to deal with anti social behaviour issues, but we will cooperate fully with all parties to help resolve any concerns. We wish all our sites to be safe, pleasant places for our customers to enjoy.

In particular, we will:-

- Communicate with all residents on our sites to provide information, advice, etc. as necessary (e.g. via circulars, newsletters, etc)
- Cooperate with Residents Associations and our customers in collecting or passing on their concerns, complaints, or evidence to the appropriate authorities
- Liaise with the relevant Local Authority for the area, as most have specialist background and knowledge in dealing with situations of anti social behaviour. Local Authorities also have the legal powers to take action where appropriate
- Liaise with the police
